MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Forms may be mailed to Robert Olson, 817 Ogden Ave. #3549, Lisle, IL 60532-8549 or emailed to secretary@livetrial.net. No phone move-ups.

Pretrial moveups (for either trial day) must be received by the trial secretary by 6:00 p.m. Monday, February 26, 2018. Day to day moveups are offered, and must be completed by the time the last ribbon is awarded on the day the title is completed.

Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs the same class.

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog will be requested to leave the trial.

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run. Conflicts between the rings should be discussed with the gate steward prior to the start of the class.

WAIT LIST: SDAC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 40 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing at 6:00 pm, February 14, 2018. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on Monday, February 26, 2018 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on February 26, 2018 will not be charged. If you do not wish to be placed on the Wait List, please mark the top of the entry form.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: bitches that come in season may have their complete entry fee returned by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian, on their letterhead, to the Trial Secretary not later than 30 minutes prior to the first class on the day of the Trial.

AWARDS: Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes will be rewarded for 1st through 4th place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at this trial. All prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed. Dogs completing MACH or PACH titles will receive a bar and ribbon; dogs completing a PAX title will receive a bar. Please contact the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net if you may be eligible for one of these titles at this show.

CATALOGS: Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial.

Veterinarian (on call) Huntley Veterinary Hospital 10301 N. Vine Street, Huntley, IL 60142 (847) 669-5888 Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Illinois law requires proof of rabies vaccination. **Simplified Jump Height Card Process:** When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate that your dog needs to be measured. If he needs to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height

card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

SAFETY: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judge's discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.

ELECTRONIC TIMERS: Smack Dab Agility Club will be using electronic timers in all rings.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at Car-Dun-Al's training facility, 10783 Wolf Drive, Huntley, IL. The training center is in the southwest corner of the second building on the right. It will be indoors on ³/₄" agility matting. There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles: they must be crated inside. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Any additional questions regarding the site and its amenities should be directed to the trial chairman.

DIRECTIONS: *From the east*, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn right (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Go less than .1 miles on Oakcrest to Wolf Drive and turn left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Road. Turn right on Harmony Road and drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Road. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right (Main Street). Drive 1.4 miles on Main Street to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Drive and turn left. (Algonquin Road to the right). Drive approximately .1 miles to Wolf Drive and turn left

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
