MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Forms may be mailed to Robert Olson, 22W462 Sycamore Dr., Glen Ellyn, IL 60137 or emailed to rdotrialsec@sbcglobal.net. No phone move-ups.

Move-ups for Friday, February 24th must be received not later than noon on Monday, February 20th.

Move-ups for Saturday, February 25th will be accepted on Friday, February 24th until the last ribbon has been awarded.

Move-ups for Sunday, February 26th will be accepted on Saturday, February 25th until the last ribbon has been awarded.

Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs the same class. *Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing date of this trial.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: On Friday, dogs are not required to be at the trial until scheduled time of judging and will be excused when not needed for further judging. **On Saturday and Sunday**, as these are Bench Shows, **ALL DOGS MUST ARRIVE BY 10:00 a.m.** and stay until announced release, no later than 4:00 p.m. Dogs must be exercised in the building.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

NO CRATING OR DOGS LOITERING WITHIN THE MARKED AREAS AROUND EACH RING AND THE SCORE TABLE.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WHEN IN DESIGNATED AGILITY WARM-UP AREAS. PER SITE COMMITTEE: NO RETRACTABLE LEASHES WILL BE ALLOWED.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog will be requested to leave the areal.

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run. Conflicts between the rings should be discussed with the gate steward prior to the start of the class.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following two exceptions: injured dogs or bitches that come into season may have their entry fee returned, less a \$5.00 per day administrative fee, by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian to the Trial Secretary by 8:00 a.m. the day of the Trial.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes and dog toys will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. A MACH bar and rosette will be awarded for teams earning their mach, at any of these trials. PLEASE let us know, in advance, if there is a chance of your team earning a MACH by informing our Awards Chairman, Kim Trzcinski, 32425 South Crawford Ave., Peotone, IL 60468, (708) 258-9766. Many special awards have been donated for Saturday, February 25, 2006. A complete description of the awards will be listed in the catalog. If you or your club is interested in donating a special award, please contact the Awards Chairman no later than February 3, 2006. All awards must be claimed the day of the Trial – none will be mailed or shipped.

HEIGHT CARD POLICY: All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary jump height card issued by the AKC must be measured by a judge of record, volunteer measuring official (VMO), or AKC representative **prior to competing**. If you have not previously submitted a copy of your AKC height card to this trial secretary, please include a copy with your entry. If a copy is not received, exhibitors of dogs jumping other than 24 inches in the Regular program and exhibitors of any dog in the Preferred program must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class. If an AKC representative or VMO is scheduled to be present at this trial, all dogs not having an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing. Armband numbers will only be issued if a height card or valid measurement has been provided to the Trial Secretary.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

In Preferred classes a dog MUST jump 4 inches lower than regular height.

In REGULAR classes handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in regular classes but not in a division lower than their proper height division. **Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This sanctioned trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

SAFETY: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

CATALOGS: Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors for no charge. Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. **There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.**

ELECTRONIC TIMERS: Blitzen Agility Club will be using electronic timers in both the Standard and the JWW rings.

DIRECTIONS TO McCORMICK PLACE NORTH:

I-55 Stevenson Expressway: Take I-55 South to Lake Shore Drive South. Exit 31st Street. Make a sharp right turn into the parking lot entrance.

I-290 Eisenhower Expressway: Exit I-94 (Indiana). Stay in right lanes. Exit I-55 North – Lake Shore Drive.

Northbound Lake Shore Drive: Exit 31st Street. Turn left at top of bridge; cross bridge; turn right into parking lot entrance.

Southbound Lake Shore Drive: Exit 31st Street. Make a sharp right turn into parking lot entrance.

I-90 Kennedy / Dan Ryan Expressways: Exit I-55 North (Lake Shore Drive). Exit 31st Street. Turn left at top of bridge; cross bridge; turn right into parking lot entrance.

EXHIBITOR PARKING AND UNLOADING:

The International Kennel Club has obtained special parking rates for all exhibitors, handlers, and agents at the 31st Street Parking Lot. McCormick Place will set aside space at the north end of the 31st Street Parking Lot. The 31st Street Parking Lot is adjacent to the show site. This lot will be managed by McCormick Place and the IKC. Off-duty police officers will provide around-the-clock security. There will be no pre-sale exhibitor parking in this lot. The 31st Street Parking Lot has been reserved for exhibitors daily until 11:00 a.m.. After that time, unused space will be available to general spectators.

Exhibitors wishing to unload prior to parking should follow the directions on this page. Dogs and equipment can be dropped off at the show site in designated holding areas staffed by knowledgeable dog people. Every person entering the building must have an admittance pass before entering benching area on Saturday and Sunday only. However, every exhibitor will need proper identification before exiting dog(s) at the conclusion of the show.
