MOVE UP REGULATIONS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing via postal mail or e-mail to the trial secretary only. Move ups for Saturday March 3rd must be received by Monday, February 26, 2007. Day to day move ups will be accepted and must be received by the awarding of the last ribbon of the day. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. Move ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing date

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and of AKC and their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veteranarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and communicable diseases, and have approproate vaccinations. Proof of current vaccinations, including rabies, must be available at the trial if requested.

All dogs must be held on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or in the designated agility warm up area.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduleded time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for dogs who are holding up the class.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Please don't allow dogs to use the shrubbery or landscaping to relieve themselves. <u>Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs or</u> <u>exercising in prohibitied areas will be asked to leave</u>. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Warm Up Area: A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Consideration should be given to those teams who are due in the ring prior to other teams wishing to use the jump.

Collars & Leashes: Dogs may run with or without collars. If collars are worn they must be flat buckle collars with no attachments. Martingale collars & choke collars are not allowed. <u>Pinch collars are not allowed on the show site. Flexi Leads are not allowed inside the building.</u>

From the East or West: I-90 (Northwest Tollway) to Route 47 North 8.5 miles to Route 176. Turn Right. Go 4.0 miles to Virginia Rd. (Route 14, Northwest Highway). Turn Left. Go 0.3 miles to Ridgefield Road, slight Right. Turn Right, go approx. 1.5 miles to Kicks Regional Sports Complex.

From the South: I-294 North I-90 West (Northwest Tollway) to Route 47 North 8.5 miles to Route 176. Turn Right. Go 4.0 miles to Virginia Rd. (Route 14, Northwest Highway). Turn Left. Go 0.3 miles to Ridgefield Road, Turn Right, go approx. 1.5 miles to Kicks Regional Sports Complex.



Dogs Eligible To Enter: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months and are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP number, or are eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous class, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate

Each dog must be entered in ONLY Regular classes OR Preferred classes for the show. Each dog must be entered in only one height division for this show.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division as shown in the table below. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes ONLY but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in Preferred MUST run in their correct height division; they may not run at a higher or lower height. Dogs shall be moved down to the proper jump height if entered in the incorrect <u>Preferred</u> class jump height only if measured by Volunteer Measuring Official, AKC Agility Field Representative or Judges of Record. Dogs that run in a regular height division lower than their proper division or in a preferred height division at other than their proper division will be eliminated. **In no case may a dog be moved down in height after closing, whether due to an exhibitor entry error or due to a judge's measurement.** The secretary is not responsible for ensuring that a dog is entered in the proper height division. Any and all errors in height division entered are solely the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Height Cards: The club will accept a photocopy of the entered dog's height card with each entry. However, exhibitors must have height cards available at the trial and be able to show them if asked. Otherwise, the dog's height must be checked either by presenting the AKC Height Card at check-in or by being measured by the judge of record **prior to running the course** including dogs jumping 24" Regular. ALL preferred dogs, including 20", must demonstrate proof that they are in the correct height. NOTE: The secretary will not take entry information from the height card—you must completely fill out your entry even though the information is supplied on your height card. **Incomplete entries will be returned. Prizes & Awards:** Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying ribbons and prizes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes and plush toys valued between \$1.00—\$5.00 will be awarded for 1st through 4th

place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at this trial. All prizes must be claimed at the trial, none will be mailed.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
