

Welcome to Collie Club of America National Specialty Agility Trial!

The building opens at 6:30 a.m. each day with judging starting at 9:00 a.m. We will be using AgilityGate for checkin. See your confirmation email and signage at the show for more details.

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, please email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (630) 456-0097. Except for the first class of the day in each ring, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the "B" or "Master" classes will run first, followed by dogs in the "A" or "Excellent" classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the "A" classes in their corresponding jump height.

The building will be opened at 6:30 AM on Sunday and we could really use help to unload the equipment trailer, put equipment together and build the first course (we do not have access before that time). Any time competitors can step up to help, it would be much appreciated.

Each day everyone must enter through the East Bump-out to have his/her temperature taken and get a wrist band on Sunday and a sticker to put on it on Monday. The wrist band is necessary for everywhere in the buildings and people will not be admitted without it.

Crating: Crating for agility will be in both the dirt barn (on the end without the ring), with overflow in the East Bump-out. The Bump-out is cement and there will need to be plastic under ex-pens. At the end of the trial on Monday, everyone will need to move their setups as both the dirt barn and the bump-out will be used for grooming spots for conformation. If your assigned grooming spot is ready, you can move right into it when agility is done.

Please keep crating set ups 6 feet apart.

Masks will be required everywhere and at all times except when actually running your dog. There will be a delineated area at the ring exit to gather up your stuff and put your mask back on before going back to your set up.

Food will be available for purchase at 7AM each day.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Included in this document are three notices from the CCA committee. These pertain to requirements due to COVID-19 precautions. Please read over them prior to attending the trial.

- 1. Practices and Guidelines. Some are different from the basic premium requirements at the herding site.
- 2. Liability Waiver: This needs to be completed and signed prior to entering the herding trial grounds.
- 3. COVID -19 Self-Declaration/Contact Tracing Form: this needs to be completed and signed prior to entering the herding trial grounds.



AGILITY Practices & Guidelines

MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY EVERYONE AT ALL TIMES

If you refuse you will be asked to leave the show ground without refund of **ANY** fees previously paid.

1. Admittance to the event areas

- a. Please be patient if there are lines.
- b. Each day Agility entrants **MUST** check in at the **EAST ENTRANCE DOOR to the Dirt barn** before entering **ANY** buildings or event areas.
- c. **EVERYONE** must <u>initially</u> turn in a signed **Waiver**, a **COVID Declaration/Contract Tracing** form, have your temperature checked, and receive a wrist band. Forms will be available at check in but to expedite the lines, please print the forms ahead of time and have them filled out when you arrive. Forms will also be available on the CCA National website and the Trial Secretary's website.
- d. You **MUST** wear your wristband at **ALL** times while you are on the show grounds. This signifies that you have submitted your required forms and have had your temperature checked.
- e. **EACH** day thereafter you must check in again and have your temperature taken. You will receive a sticker if your temperature is within the acceptable range. You **MUST** wear this sticker in a visible place on your person at **ALL** times.
- f. If you are not wearing a wristband, you will be directed back to the check-in areas to fill out the required forms and have your temperature checked before being allowed into any building or event area.
- g. If you do not have a sticker, you will be directed back to the check-in area to have your temperature taken and receive a sticker before being allowed into any building or event area.

NO WRISTBAND – NO STICKER – NO ADMITTANCE – NO EXCEPTION

If you refuse, you will be asked to leave the show grounds

2. Inside Event Buildings and Event Areas

- a. MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES except when eating and drinking.
- b. Exhibitors may also run their dog without a mask if they desire.
- c. If you are using a face shield you must also wear a face mask.
- d. If you are unable to wear a face mask for medical reasons, we are unable to alter our plans to accommodate you due to the size of the event and the burden. If you would like to enter your dog, we suggest you have a friend or a handler that can follow these guidelines run your dog.
- e. Even if you have received one or both of the COVID-19 vaccines, you must still wear a face mask.
- f. There will be hand sanitizer station around the grounds.
- g. Consider wearing disposable gloves.
- h. Wash hands as much as possible.
- i. Avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact.
- j. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- k. Avoid common use pens/pencils bring your own.
- I. Please consider leaving the grounds once you are done for the day.

3. Exhibitors

- a. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring your own sanitizers, hand wipes, and masks.
- b. Know your arm band number before you go to the ring.
- c. Follow all instructions given by the ring stewards for entrance to and exit from the ring and the ring area.
- d. Do not gather for your walkthrough until called.
- e. Remember to keep the 6' social distance between you and other exhibitors both inside and outside of the rings.
- f. This is a self- cleaning show, please be aware of what your Collie is doing! Be prepared to clean up after your own dog.
- g. NO private chairs will be allowed around any rings.
- h. Spectator numbers MAY be limited based on current Laramie County/Wyoming restrictions.
- i. Food Trucks will be available, and you are allowed to bring your own food.
- j. Please dispose of all used masks and gloves in appropriate waste receptacles.
- k. It is strongly suggested that each exhibitor have a contingency plan in place for themselves and their dogs in case of sudden illness.

4. Crating

- a. All crating spaces will be socially distanced and planned.
- b. Additional crating space will be available in an adjacent room.
- c. No electric will be available in the crating areas.
- d. There will be NO DRYERS OR FANS allowed in the crating area.
- e. Only battery operated crate fans will be allowed on individual crates.
- f. If your dogs are left overnight in the building, make sure their crates have an emergency card attached with the Dog's Name, Your Name, and a cell phone number to reach you.
- g. Dog bathing stations will be available. You must bring your own shampoo and towels.
- h. There will be two drying stations (tables) set up outdoors for your use. Electricity will be available here; you will need to bring your own dryer.
- i. Avoid displaying high touch items in your crating areas: bowls of candy, photo albums, pedigrees etc.
- j. Consider bringing disinfecting spray to spray down surfaces that are touched by many people.
- k. Please consider crating dogs in your vehicle if the weather is acceptable.

Failure to comply with any of these practices or guidelines may result in you being asked to leave the event grounds and/or may result in a CCA Show Committee hearing and disciplinary action.

These Practices and Guidelines are subject to change at any time based on changes to state, local, or CCA National Show Committee guidance. Please see the CCA National website for any updates to the COVID Practices.

WAIVER

If you will be at the Laramie County Fairgrounds or Rancho Terra Norte for any of the CCA Events or Activities during the Collie Club of America's Event Week, April 16 through April 25, 2021, in any capacity, you must complete this waiver prior to admittance and bring it with you to gain entry. Upon our receipt of your signed waiver you will receive your entry wrist band that you MUST wear each day that you are on the show grounds.

THERE ARE NO EXCLUSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS.

I am fully aware of the risks involved with entering the Laramie County Fairgrounds (herein, the "Fairgrounds") premises and facilities located at the Laramie County Fairgrounds, Cheyenne, Wyoming as well as any transportation and/or hotel associated with the Fairgrounds, Archer Center, the Ranch Terre Norte and/or the Collie Club of America National("CCA") (Collectively, the "Facilities") during the COVID-19 pandemic (or with respect to any related or similar infection, which together are herein referred to as "COVID-19"). I am entering into this Waiver knowingly and on my own behalf.

As a condition of my being allowed to enter the Facilities, I will fully comply with: (i) any health and safety requirements; and (ii) all local, state and federal requirements, each of (i) - (ii) as amended from time to time (collectively, the "COVID-19 Protocols"). If I test positive for COVID-19 or am exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, I agree to notify someone in charge promptly and before reentering the Facilities.

I acknowledge that the risks involved with entering the Facilities and being in the presence of other people during the COVID-19 pandemic include, but are not limited to, contracting COVID-19, respiratory failure, death, and transmitting COVID-19 to family or household members and others who may also suffer these effects. I further understand that compliance with the COVID-19 Protocols will not eliminate these risks, even with social distancing and other safety measures in place at the Facilities. Notwithstanding the foregoing, I elect to voluntarily participate in entering the Facilities with full knowledge that doing so may be hazardous to my health and those with whom I may come into contact.

I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any risks of loss or personal injury, including serious illness, injury or death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, as a result of my presence in the Facilities, whether caused by the negligence of the CCA or the Fairgrounds. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I release, waive, forever discharge responsibility and covenant not to sue the CCA, Fairgrounds, Rancho Terra Norte and their respective affiliates and each of the foregoing's respective administrators, members, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, sponsors, vendors, contractors, medical services providers, judges, superintendents or event secretary, and agents, (the "Releasees") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, illness, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees, other entities or individuals, or otherwise as a result of, or related to, my decision to enter the Facilities.

I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREE THAT IT IS VALID FOREVER. It is my express intent that this Waiver binds; (i) the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and (ii) my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased. I understand that this Waiver does not apply to any claim that, as a matter of law, cannot be released by private agreement.

If any of the provisions, terms or clauses of this Waiver is declared illegal, unenforceable or ineffective in a legal forum, those provisions, terms and clauses shall be deemed severable, such that all other provisions, terms and clauses of this Waiver shall remain valid and binding upon both parties.

I agree that any controversy or claim between me and any of the Releasees arising out of or relating to this Waiver or my presence at the Facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic shall be resolved by confidential, final and binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") pursuant to the Federal Arbitration Act ("FAA"). All proceedings brought pursuant to this paragraph will proceed before a single arbitrator, who shall be an experienced arbitrator licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado, take place in the County of Denver, State of Colorado, and be conducted in accordance with AAA's applicable rules. The parties agree that (i) any and all issues relating to arbitration or this arbitration clause, including, without limitation, the threshold question of arbitrability or the enforcement or validity of this arbitration clause, will be delegated to the arbitrator selected pursuant to this provision, (ii) the arbitrator will have the power to award any remedies, including, attorneys' fees and costs, available under applicable law, (iii) judgment upon the award that the arbitrator renders may be entered in any court having jurisdiction, and (iv) the arbitrator's award may be vacated or modified only on the grounds specified in the FAA or other applicable law.

I agree that all controversies and claims between me and any of the Releasees arising out of or relating to this Waiver or my presence at the Facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic must be pursued on an individual basis only. By signing this Waiver, I waive my right to commence, or be a party to any class actions or collective claims against the Releasees.

I agree that this Waiver shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Wyoming without giving effect to any laws, rules or provisions that would cause the application of laws of any jurisdiction other than those of the State of Wyoming.

If you will be at the Laramie County Fairgrounds or Rancho Terra Norte for any of the CCA Events or Activities during the Collie Club of America's Event Week, April 16 through April 25, 2021, in any capacity, you must complete this waiver prior to admittance and bring it with you to gain entry. Upon our receipt of your signed waiver you will receive your entry wrist band that you must wear each day that you are on the show grounds.

THERE ARE NO EXCLUSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS. If you attempt to enter at any facility without a wristband you will be required to return to the main check in area and fill out and sign a new declaration form to receive a new wristband.

1. Within the last 14 days, I have not experienced any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 nor have I taken medication to reduce fever during that time.
