# Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America, Inc. National Specialty AKC Agility Trial September 16, 2019

### WELCOME

Welcome to your National Specialty! We hope you all have a great time.

The building opens at **6:30 a.m.** Please do not arrive earlier than this, per the hosting site requirements. See the judging schedule for the start time for your classes.



Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, please email the trial secretary at secretary@livetrial.net (preferred) or phone (815) 242-5483. Except for the first class of the day in each ring, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the "B" or "Master" classes will run first, followed by dogs in the "A" or "Excellent" classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the "A" classes in their corresponding jump height. Walk throughs will be split at the discretion of the judges.

**MEASUREMENT:** If you do not have a height card, your dog will need to be measured for the day by judge Ronda Bermke.

**SITE INFORMATION:** As always, clean up after your dog. Remember that hotels are considered by the AKC to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. We'd like to be able to keep using these hotels for dog shows, so please continue to be exemplary dog owners.

No barking dogs allowed in vehicles. They must be crated inside.

Do not walk your dogs along the fence on the west side of the drainage area. Walk dogs on the east side of the drainage area and along the south side of the buildings.

**FOOD**: Food will be *not* available for purchase on-site; preorders are due by September 9. See the trial premium for information.

**CRATING:** Please, no X-pens allowed. Crate in the marked crating areas. No dogs in the first row of seats next to the ring. Protective matting is required under all wire dog crates and chairs to protect green flooring.


**PARKING:** Do not park directly in front of other businesses. No parking is permitted in parking spots directly in front of gymnastic club next to the trial site.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:**

Car-Dun-Al Dog Training Club 10783 Wolf Drive Huntley, Illinois 60142

*From the east*, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn right (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Go less than .1 miles on Oakcrest to Wolf Drive and turn left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Road. Turn right on Harmony Road and drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Road. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right (Main Street). Drive 1.4 miles on Main Street to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Drive and turn left. (Algonquin Road to the right). Drive approximately .1 miles to Wolf Drive and turn left



#### DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE from the Nationals Host Hotel

No toll required.

Exit show site onto East Main St (North Avenue / IL 64) and turn left (west).

Follow IL64 for about a mile to Kirk Rd.

Turn right (north) on Kirk Rd. Follow Kirk for 1.6 mi where it meets Dunham, and continue straight for 2.8 mi. Dunham will become IL25. Continue straight for 2.5 mi.

When IL25 turns to the right, continue straight for 0.1 mi and turn left onto Dwight St. (Follow the sign for West US 20).

Turn left onto Grace St. and follow the on-ramp to US 20.

Follow US 20 for 3.7 mi and take the Randall Rd exit.

Turn left onto Randall Rd. Follow Randall for 6.3 miles to Huntley Rd.

Turn left onto Huntley Rd and follow for 1.2 mi.

Turn left to remain on Huntley Rd and follow for 2.5 mi. Road name will change to Dundee Rd.


Continue for another 1.5 mi. Turn right on Ruth Rd and follow for 0.7 mi.

Turn left on W. Algonquin Rd for 1.0 mi.

Turn left at Wolf Dr (this is the first left after the light at IL47). The Car-Dun-Al building is at the back (southwest) corner of the industrial park.

Important: if you follow navigation app directions, by default they will route you via Interstate 90. That works fine, but you will need to pay a toll to get off the road either via I-Pass transponder or online – there is no cash option at that exit.

Please note also the directions may try to take you via 4th street; that does not go through. Turn left at Algonquin Road off IL-47 instead.
