## AKC Agility Trial

May 26 – 27, 2018



### **WELCOME**

Welcome to the Smack Dab May trial! We hope you all have a great time.

The building opens at **6:30 a.m.** each day. Judging begins at 8:00 a.m. in the Standard ring and 8:40 a.m. in the T2B/JWW ring each day. Friday setup will begin around 6:00 p.m. for anyone willing to help unload the truck. The truck must be done before anyone may set up their crating area.

Please review your enclosed entry information. If there are any errors or problems, email the trial secretary at [secretary@livetrial.net](mailto:secretary@livetrial.net) (preferred) or phone (630) 790-8426. Except for the first class of the day in each ring, all start times are approximate. Dogs in the “B” / Master classes will run first, followed by dogs in the “A” / Excellent classes for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the “A” / Excellent classes in their corresponding jump height. Walk-throughs will be split according to the schedule on the judging program. FAST classes will run with a single walkthrough, and in these classes dogs in the Preferred program will run before dogs in the Regular program in each jump height.

**MEASUREMENT:** If your dog does not have a height card he will need to be measured by one of the judges before you can run. We will not have a VMO at this trial.

### **SITE INFORMATION:**

- **There is no parking available for RVs.**
- **Please only walk the dogs on the designated 'pathed' walkways set out due to the new track that sits next to the turf area**
- **Absolutely no grooming of dogs (nail trimming / grinding, brushing, hair trimming) permitted. We need to keep the fur down to a minimum if at all possible and please keep areas picked up/tidy**

As always, clean up after your dog. Remember that hotels are considered by the AKC to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. We'd like to be able to keep using these hotels for dog shows, so please continue to be exemplary dog owners.

**FOOD:** Concessions will not available on site, but there are restaurants in the area. Food may be brought in but no food or beverages are allowed on the turf fields.

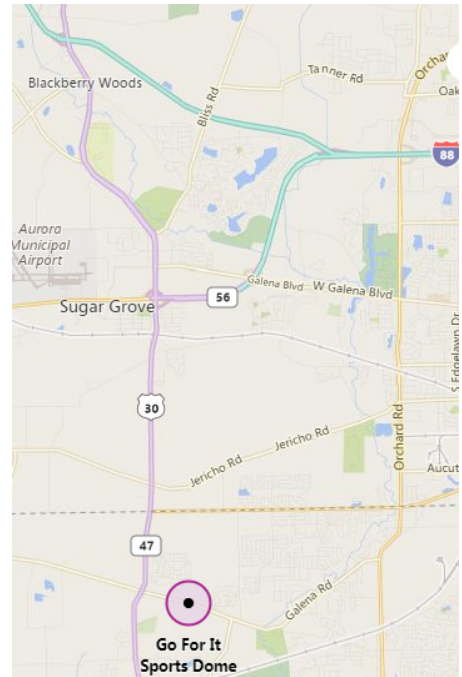
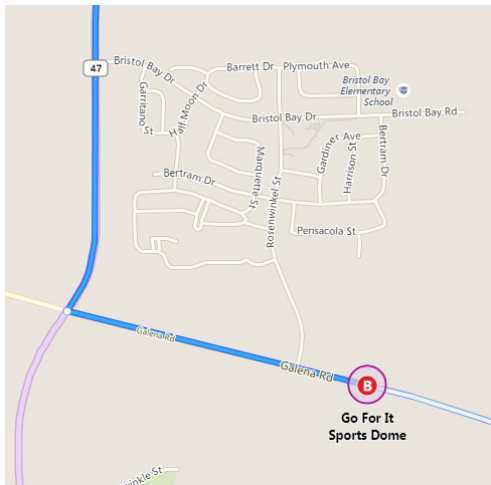
**CRATING:** Mats are required to be placed under your crates. Space will be tight so please try to conserve space as much as possible.
