**AKC Code of Sportsmanship**

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

**HEALTH CLINIC:**

**JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

**Novice.** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open.** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class.

**Master.** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOTICE:** Junior handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC Event Records Department at 212-696-8281. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship is entered on the front and back of entry form.

## **SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES**

(Rough/smooth combined)

Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular classes. Entry fee shall be \$10.00 for each puppy and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the regular classes, in the space for "additional classes." All entries in the puppy sweepstakes must also be entered and shown in a regular class at the regular fee. The entry will be divided into six classes, the first place puppy from each of these six classes shall constitute a winners class which shall compete for Best Puppy in Sweeps.

### **CLASSIFICATION**

Puppy, 6 months & under 9 months, dogs; puppy, 9 months & under 12 months, dogs; 12 months and under 18 months, dogs. (Same classes for bitches)

### **DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY**

30% of entry fee will be retained to offset expenses

First place, each class .....40% of 1/7th of the stake

Second place, each class .....30% of 1/7th of the stake

Third place, each class .....20% of 1/7th of the stake

Fourth place, each class .....10% of 1/7th of the stake

Best puppy in sweepstakes .....100% of 1/7th of the stake

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. All illegible or incomplete forms may be returned. Show secretary assumes no responsibility for incorrect entry information due to illegibility of the entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on entry forms with the AKC agreement printed on the reverse side or they will be returned.

Catalogs may be pre-ordered by checking the selection on your entry form and including an additional \$4 with your entry fees. There will be a limited number of catalogs available the day of the show at a cost of \$5.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show

Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Only entered dogs are permitted on the grounds. Any dog causing a disturbance must be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash at all times. Please stack crates when possible. Exercise pens will be allowed at the show chairman's discretion.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

**NO SMOKING** allowed in the building

Dogs are not required to be at the show until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when required for judging.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors must comply with the Illinois Department of Agriculture Rule.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

**SITE INFORMATION:** This show will be held at the Francis 4-H Field facility at 801 E. Francis Road, New Lenox, IL 60451. Food is available on site, and there are fast food restaurants nearby.

**SHOW SITE/RV HOOK-UP:** Electrical hook up only available for \$25 a day. Must notify Show Secretary in advance.

## **AKC Sanctioned 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Conformation Special Attraction**

The 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition is intended to introduce new exhibitors and their puppies to the show world in a stress-free and relaxed environment. It also provides an opportunity for puppies to socialize with people and other dogs at an optimal time of their development. Puppies may earn points towards a Certificate of Merit at these competitions. Neutered puppies may not be entered in this event. **NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTICIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Conformation Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months of age on the day of the event.

- One Combined Class (Dogs & Bitches) will be offered for each Variety (Rough & Smooth)
- Best of Variety Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety Beginner Puppy will be awarded in each Variety.
- Selection of Best of Breed Beginner Puppy will be between the Variety winners.

An AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges.

Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Month Puppy Competition. No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard)

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
