**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:**

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

An exercise area will be provided. All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog will be requested to leave the trial.

The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run. Conflicts between the rings should be discussed with the gate steward prior to the start of the class.

**MEASURING:** When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate that your dog needs to be measured. If your dog needs to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24” height division. However if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep. is present ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor’s responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so may result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

## Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

### Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
  - Toys must be non-audible
  - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
  - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

## Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

**MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:** Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the trial secretary only. Forms may be mailed to Robert Olson, 817 Ogden Ave. #3549, Lisle, IL 60532-8549 or emailed to secretary@livetrial.net. No phone move-ups.

Pretrial moveups (for either trial day) must be received by the trial secretary by 6:00 p.m. Monday, April 27, 2020. Day to day moveups are offered, and must be completed by the time the last ribbon is awarded on the day the title is completed.

Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs the same class.

*A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.*

**WAIT LIST:** NOCI is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 40 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing at 7:00 pm, April 10, 2020. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on Monday, April 27, 2020 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on April 27, 2020 will not be charged. If you do not wish to be placed on the Wait List, please mark the top of the entry form.

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: bitches that come in season or injured dogs may have their entry fee less \$10 per day returned by sending a signed statement from a veterinarian, on the veterinarian's letterhead, to the Trial Secretary not later than 30 minutes prior to the first class on the day of the Trial.

**AWARDS:** One treat bag, from The Liver Lady, will be given to each dog entered for the entire weekend. Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place in each class and height division. Dogs earning qualifying scores will receive an appropriate color qualifying ribbon. A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. PLEASE let us know, in advance, if there is a chance of your team earning a MACH/PACH at our trial (so that we can make sure we have enough)! A Double Q flat ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain a qualifying score in both Master STD and Master JWW on the same day. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial – none will be shipped.

**CATALOGS:** Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, check the catalog box on your entry form and include \$15.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the trial.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

*Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Illinois law requires proof of rabies vaccination.*

**SAFETY:** The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/OBSTACLES:** Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. The walk-through may be split at the judge's discretion. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. **There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs at any of these trials.**

**ELECTRONIC TIMERS:** NOCI will be using electronic timers in all rings.

**SITE INFORMATION:** The agility trial will be held at Car-Dun-Al's training facility, 10783 Wolf Drive, Huntley, IL. The training center is in the southwest corner of the second building on the right. It will be indoors on ¾" agility matting. There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles: they must be crated inside. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Any additional questions regarding the site and its amenities should be directed to the trial chairman.

**DIRECTIONS: From the east,** take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn left (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Go 0.2 miles on Oakcrest to Wolf Drive and turn left.

**From the west,** take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Road. Turn right on Harmony Road and drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Road. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right (Main Street). Drive 1.4 miles on Main Street to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Drive and turn left. (Algonquin Road to the right). Drive approximately 0.2 miles to Wolf Drive and turn left
