The Western English Setter Club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Exhibitors are advised to print all unusual words when filling in entry forms.

No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after the closing of entries, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless. of who may make such error. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms with the agreement printed on the reverse side. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted if legible.

No entry fees will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of the management. 
